### **YOUR PARTICIPATION MATTERS!**

This EGM is of critical importance as the residents can elect a new executive committee to lead our community for the upcoming term. The current committee has decided not to continue its responsibilities beyond 31st December 2024, allowing a fresh and capable team to take charge of our Welfare Society.

### **Why Your Participation is Vital**

The executive committee plays a pivotal role in ensuring the smooth operation and sustainability of our residential community. The decisions made by the committee directly impact on the quality of life for all residents. It is your responsibility to:

- Actively participate in the EGM.
- Nominate and support individuals who are capable, visionary, and committed to serving the best interests of our community.
- Ensure the elected members represent all areas of the city, fostering better understanding and communication across our neighborhood.

The sustainability of your city lies in your hands. Without your proactive involvement and failure to nominate suitable candidates, there is a risk that committee members will be haphazardly selected, sometimes based on friendships and personal agendas, without considering the gravity of the responsibilities. This could lead to unacceptable repercussions for the whole community.

### **Transparent Nomination Process**

The MCRWS has developed a constitution to prevent haphazard entries. But for this year only, the current committee will lift constitutional barriers with your consent only at the EGM to allow new residents to be nominated, fostering greater inclusivity. At the last AGM held on 7th December, the lack of participation (46 attendees only) hindered our ability to lift certain constitutional barriers.

We have already announced that residents can submit nominations, but no official nominations have been received to date.

### **Steps to Nominate a Candidate:**

To ensure a fair and inclusive election, MCRWS has established a structured and transparent nomination process.

**Eligibility:** The nominee must be a house owner, spouse, or unmarried child. Tenants, proxies, or other relatives (father, mother, uncle, aunt, or other relatives in law who are not the owner of the property) are not eligible. The nominator must also meet these criteria.

**Download Nomination Form:** Download the form here <https://mch.budgetweb.shop/nominations> or collect it from the MCRWS office.

**Fill Out the Form:** Provide details of the nominee, ensuring their consent and signature.

**Submission Deadline:** Submit the completed form to the MCRWS office by 19<sup>th</sup> December 2024.

### **Additional Measures**


MCRWS also emphasizes the importance of residents taking responsibility for nominating capable members. If the residents fail to act, it could compromise the welfare and functionality of our community.
